#### **Installation Requirements**


Pentarch Engineered Herringbone Parquetry™ must be glued down over a level subfloor such as a concrete slab, particleboard or plywood sheeting or over old timber floors. It is recommended that parquetry flooring in installed by a professional as it requires specific methodology and equipment.

#### **Care & Maintenance**

With regular care and maintenance, you can enjoy a lifetime of beauty with your Pentarch Engineered Flooring.

- For daily cleaning, use dry methods such as vacuuming and sweeping. To remove stubborn dirt, use a well-rung mop and a pH neutral cleaner. Do not clean timber floors with a steam mop.
- Place doormats at entrances, non-slip rugs in high-wear areas and protective pads under furniture legs.
- Do not use any abrasive brushes, steel wool, soap detergents or ammonia based cleaners.
- Always take care when moving appliances and furniture by placing them on a sturdy mat to slide into position.
